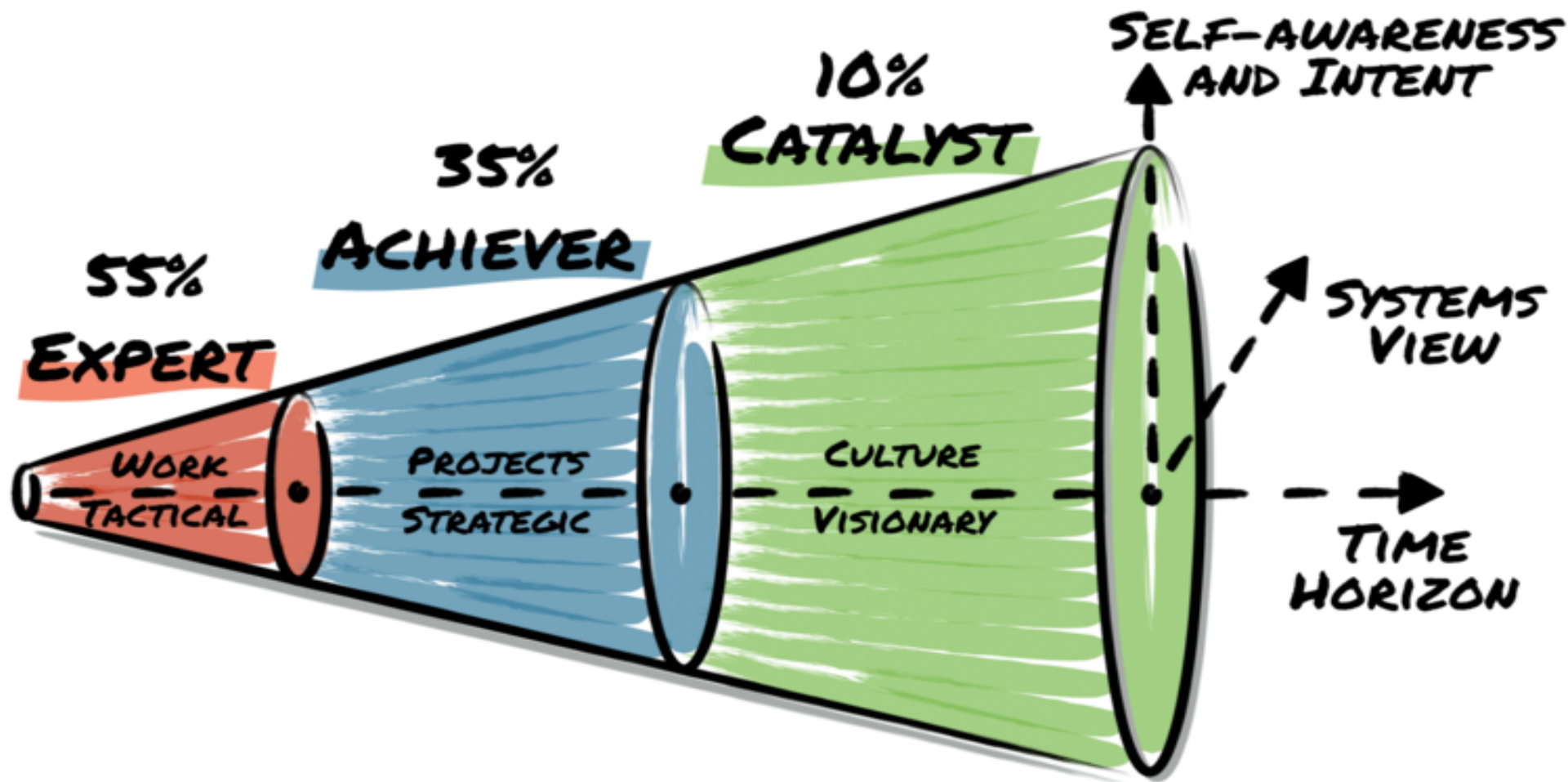

- Unaccommodating Organizational Culture



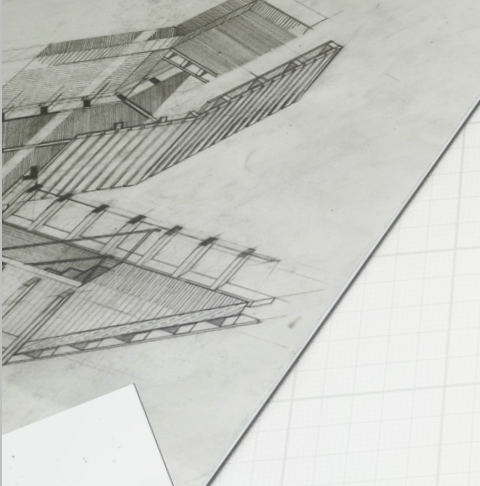
